
Elephant Man - Overview

- Successful run 5-6 December at the Polanentheater
- Difficult weekend to sell a full house as it fell on Sinterklaas, but still maintained a loss of only ~ €630 (breakdown in next section, does not include income from new membership)
- Over 75% of the cast and crew were new members, however today only 3 participants are active InPlayers members
- Recruited specifically for dancers, however found it very difficult to maintain commitment throughout the production



Elephant Man - Key Takeaways

- Active effort was made for next show to be more "light hearted" to switch things up after a more serious play (i.e. Noir Suspicions) to keep with Core Value of a diverse season
- If InPlayers would like to do a show with dance requirements in the future, we should first ensure we are accredited to provide internship hours
- Looked for ways to build more community within a show and within InPlayers as a whole
- As we have the Sinterklaas weekend again at the Polanen for 2020, we intentionally "leant in" and are producing a Christmas production



Our aim is to produce at least three main stage shows per year

Submission process proposed change

rolling submissions

- Current process is constantly rolling submissions throughout the season
- Once a viable play has been submitted and pre-approved by the committee, a notification (via email) is sent to the community notifying that a option is being considered for a specific date
- The community then has 2 weeks to respond in case someone else was wanting to submit for the same dates

Proposed Change:

- Committee more actively drives the vision for the season
- All community members are encouraged to submit ideas for show they want to see put on and/or direct, however the goal is that by the AGM in 2021, the 2021/2022 season is already announced
- Committee may select a show they think would be good for the season, and seek directors afterwards
- Allows members when paying dues in September, to already know what the mainstage shows will be
- In the interim (2020/2021 season), the 2 week probationary period is removed

Proposed change only works if we live our core value of openness and communication, we want to put on shows that our members want to be in! Stop by a committee meeting anytime.
